Hazard Tree - Tree Appraisal Workshop

Trees are hazardous when the failure of one or more of their parts results in property damage and/or personal injury. All trees have the potential to fail, but only a relative few actually do so.

This workshop will concentrate on trees growing in urban areas, recognizing the unique combinations of species and site character found in cities.

Arborists know that trees have value beyond their aesthetic contributions to a landscape and that their value can be assessed. We will examine the methods of establishing the value of trees in the urban environment.

Plant valuations are not limited to casualty situations but can include appraisals for tree inventories, real estate transactions, plant condemnation actions and insurance purposes. We will discuss the **Cost Approach**, the **Income Approach**, and the **Market Approach** for assigning a value to trees. We'll also learn about the **Cost of Repair** and **Replacement Cost to Trunk Formula** and **Cost of Cure**.
